Code Enforcement

Weeds, Junk Cars, Etc.

Weed letters will be going out if weeds are about 12" tall. Also, junk cars in yards will be addressed. Fines are \$249.00 for Any code violation and can be assessed weekly. Any junk vehicle Not taken care of in a timely manner will be towed at the owners expense. Any yards not taken care of in a timely manner will be mowed by an Employee of the town and the property owner will be bill \$200.00 per hour. Please keep yards Clean, if you have a question of what might be considered a code violation, please contact Brett Howe at 580-532-5079 or Town Hall at 580-388-4360.
